During 2014, Beyond Access worked with three pilot libraries in Pucallpa, Trujillo and Yauya. These libraries received equipment, software and training support.

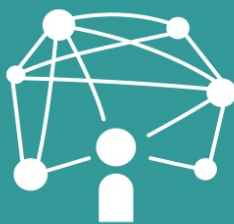
36% increase in library visits

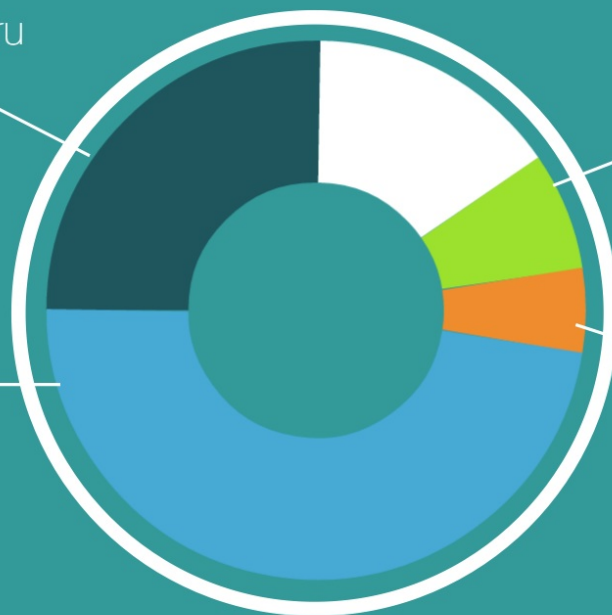
